
Business services in a nutshell


Lublin, due to the availability of talents and high quality office spaces is now seen as one of the key locations for business services companies in Poland.

Lublin is one of the most prospective cities in terms of locating business services operations. The rapid rise in the importance of the BSS sector in Lublin occured due to its improved accessibility, numerous infrastructural projects, a growing office market and, on the top of that, a pool of of skilled and loyal talents with high work ethics educated by 9 local universities and colleges. Thanks to a continuously growing population of students from abroad, the city is proud to be the most internationalised big city in Poland – 13.8% of students are foreigners. Lublin is home to 36 BPO/SSC/IT centres which employ at least 100 people, and the total employment in BPO/SSC/IT and R&D centres is over 14,000. Smart and consistent policies implemented by the city's authorities, lower labour and office lease costs. effective collaboration between businesses. universities and the City Hall administration, as well as high quality of living are some of the most important competitive advantages of Lublin.


















DataArt - trusted partner for world's leading brands

Billennium is a Polish company providing IT services for clients from all over the world, and its operations on a global scale are managed from a modern Service Delivery Centre in Lublin.

Established in 2003 in Warsaw. Billennium creates innovative IT solutions using its expertise in outsourcing, software development and cloud computing. Orange Polska – the first SSC in Lublin

The Orange Polska Accounting Shared Services is one of the first shared service centres in Lublin, which marked the beginning of the growth of Lublin's BSS sector.

The Accounting Shared Services was established to provide high quality financial and accounting services to companies of the Orange Polska group. Other locations in Poland were considered too. Ultimately, it was decided to choose Lublin due to its strong infrastructure, large academic population, low market saturation and the attractiveness of the city. Since October 2006, when operations were launched, daily practice confirms that it was the right decion. Lublin offers great conditions to companies in the BSS sector, namely qualified employees, high schools, a rapidly developing office market, high quality of municipal services and tourist attractions. It is not yet as famous as the more popular tourist cities like Cracow, Wrocław and the TriCity, but this also means that the local market is not as saturated. Thus, Lublin is the ideal location for a second branch in Poland, the existence of which is often necessitated by in-house standards and safety considerations.

The city's potential is further increased by its air and road links. Local government, meanwhile, supports contact between business and academia, with the objective of educating skilled employees of tomorrow, and also offers assistance in finding suitable office space. The conditions have been created that enable further dynamic development of B2B sector.
